

Boels Ladies Tour Junior Women

1 -2 September

Regulations



Article 1: Organization

The Boels Ladies Tour 2018 is organized by Boels Ladies Tour, under the Regulations of the KNWU. The Boels Ladies Tour 2018 junior women is to be held September 1st- 2th 2018. The race is part of the Healthy Ageing Tour Classification.

Article 2: Type of event

The Boels Ladies Tour 2018 is open to athletes of the category junior women.

Article 3: Regulations

The race is under the regulations of the KNWU.

Article 4: Race Headquarters

Saturday September 1; Sportzone Limburg, Parijs Boulevard 335 in Sittard.

Sunday September 2; Het Kadehuis, Kade 24 in Roosendaal.

The registration of the riders will be in the permanence on Saturday September 1 at 11.00 h. Riders have to use one number on their back and a frame number. Foreign riders will receive a transponder and are obligatory to use it. These transponders need to be given back at the permanence after the race in Roosendaal.

Article 5: programm

Stage 1; Saturday September 1; Sittard, Start 14.00, Distance 65 km.

Stage 2; Saturday September 1; Time Trial Sittard, Start 17.00, Distance 2,3 km.

Stage 3; Roosendaal, Start 11.30, Distance, 50 km.

Article 6: General classification

The classification is established by adding the number of scored points. In case of an equal classification, the best time of stage 2, the individual time trial, is decisive.

Points for the general classification

In all three stages the first 20 ranked riders will receive points: 25, 22, 19, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.

Article 7: Yellow jersey

The leader of the general classification is obligatory to wear the yellow jersey. For the winner of stage 1, there will be a yellow skin suit available, which is obligatory to wear during the individual time trial.

Article 8: Attendance at the start

The riders must be present 15 minutes before the official start.

Article 9: Time Trial

Each 30 seconds a rider will start. The starting procedure is the result of stage 1 backwards. The winner of stage 1 will start in the end being the last rider. Riders who are taken out of the race during stage 1, will start first. Cars are not allowed to follow riders. 15 minutes before the start the riders have to be at the start for a bike check.

Article 10: Prizes

For the general classification after stage 3 there will be 20 prizes available. 1/50 euro, 2/45 euro, 3/35 euro, 4/30 euro, 5/30 euro, 6/30 euro, 7/25 euro, 8/25 euro, 9/20 euro, 10/20 euro, 11/15 euro, 12/15 euro, 13/15 euro, 14/10 euro, 15/10 euro, 16/10 euro, 17/10 euro, 18/5 euro, 19/5 euro, 20/5 euro. The prizes will be available after the finish of stage 3 in Roosendaal.

Article 11: Finishing Time Limits

There is no time limit. Riders who are taken out of the race in stage 1, are able to start in stage 2 (individual time trial). These riders will start first in the time trial.

Article 12: Awards Ceremony

The riders, qualified for honouring, are obliged to go to the victory platform within 10 minutes after crossing the finish line, in order to take part in the awards ceremony. The stage winner and the leader of the general classification are qualified for honouring.

At the honouring after the last stage, the numbers 1 to 3 of the final individual classification and the stage winner are expected at the podium.

Article 13: Penalties

Violation of the Regulations is penalised according to the rules decreed by the KNWU for this purpose.
